This term was first used in Venice, Italy, when ship passengers were forced to wait for a period of 40 days before landing. This practice was prevalent in the 14th and 15th Centuries when the plague was spreading at a rapid pace. Many governments

across the world have now ordered mass quarantines to fight the coronavirus pandemic.




